Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.54 dated 27.02.2018 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 420/506 IPC read with Sections 4 & 5 of Prize Chits and Money Circulation Schemes (Banning) Act, 1978, at Police Station Tripuri Patiala, District Patiala, on the basis of compromise dated 23.03.2018 (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to order dated 19.04.2018 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 30.04.2018 to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Patiala, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.432, dated 10.07.2018 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Patiala, vide Endst. No.3414/AL, dated 12.07.2018.

According to the report, learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class,

Patiala, is satisfied that compromise entered into between the parties is

genuine, voluntary, without any coercion or undue influence with their free will.

Considering the report of learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Patiala, dated 10.07.2018 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, FIR No.54 dated 27.02.2018 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 420/506 IPC read with Sections 4 & 5 of Prize Chits and Money Circulation Schemes (Banning) Act, 1978, at Police Station Tripuri Patiala, District Patiala, is quashed, subject to payment of costs of ₹10,000/-, out of which ₹6,000/- shall be deposited with the Punjab State Legal Services Authority and ₹4,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana High Court.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
