The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of order dated 16.03.2018 passed by learned JMIC, Faridabad in case FIR No. 106 dated 14.07.2017, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341 IPC and Sections 325 and 307 IPC added subsequently, registered at Police Station Tigaon, District Faridabad whereby he was declared proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was never served. It is nowhere mentioned in the impugned order that the petitioner avoided Court proceedings or he did not appear in the Court inspite of having knowledge of the case. Without effecting proper service and without following the procedure as per law, the petitioner has been

declared proclaimed offender. Petitioner is ready to join investigation.

Notice of motion has already been issued.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and joined the proceedings before it in compliance of the order dated 19.04.2018 passed in CRM-M-14508 of 2018. In case the petitioner appears before the trial Court, if not appeared earlier, he be released on interim bail to its satisfaction.

Petition stands disposed of.
