The present appeal is filed against trial and appellate courts orders dated 09.08.1988 and 12.05.1990 respectively.

2. In the instant appeal, short question for consideration is whether appellant being Sanskrit Lecturer is he entitled to pay scale of Rs.300-25-450/25-600 or not? Both the courts below have held that appellant is not entitled to the aforesaid scale. The appellant has not apprised this court by producing any rules/regulations/official memorandum/executive order that the post of Lecturer (Sanskrit) carries the pay scale of Rs.300/- to 600/- as on the date of filing of suit. Thus, there is no error committed by the trial and appellate courts so as to interfere with their decision. Accordingly, appellant has not made out a case. Appeal stands dismissed. However,

rejection of appeal would not come in the way of claiming benefit of pay scale of Rs.300/- to 600/- if the proposal as on the date of filing suit is implemented by the respondent-Education Department.
