Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners Bhupinder Singh Jaura and Netar Singh Garewal in case registered by way of FIR No.037 dated 12.02.2018 at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga under Sections 354/365/380/427/447/457/506/511 IPC and Section 25/27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 05.04.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from SI Balbir Singh from Police Station City South, Moga who submits that the petitioners are no longer required for further investigation and the weapons have already been recovered from them and nothing remains to

be recovered from them and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 05.04.2018 is made absolute however they shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, the petitioners will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
