Though the offence allegedly committed by the petitioner is obviously deplorable, he allegedly having substituted another person to appear in an examination, it is not denied that no recovery is to be effected from him and all three other co-accused have been admitted to bail.

Consequently, upon the petitioner joining investigation, if he is sought to be arrested, he would be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Ilaqua Magistrate, during the period of investigation.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
