This is second bail application filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail in case FIR No.38 dated 19.08.2016 registered under Sections 302, 325, 120-B, 336 and 148 read with Section 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Sehna, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that only a simple injury with stick to Joda Singh has been attributed to the petitioner. The petitioner did not cause any injury to deceased Bant Singh. The petitioner is in custody since 22.08.2016. The complainant has been examined in the matter.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel submits that there was active participation of the petitioner in the crime.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that the complainant's family was called for settlement with regard to dispute of plot between the parties. After deliberation had collapsed, a call was made to deceased Bant Singh and again the parties were summoned. Seeing them, the fire shots were resorted to in which two persons, namely, brother of complainant Bant Singh and his son Jagdev Singh were killed. It is submitted that the incident had not happened due to some grave and sudden provocation rather it was a pre-planned murder.

Heard.

Considering the gravity of the offence and the manner in which the crime was executed, the Court feels that no case for bail is made out at this stage.

Dismissed.

However, considering the fact that the incident happened on 19.08.2016, the trial Court is directed to make an endeavour to conclude the trial expeditiously.
