Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.147 dated 16.07.2002, registered at Police Station Nawashahar Sadar, under Sections 323, 324 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1-State and contested the present petition.

Respondent No.2-complainant has also appeared through his counsel.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned

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Learned counsel for respondent No.2-complainant states that compromise has already been effected between the parties and qua co-accused, offences have already been compounded. She further submits that the complainant is ready to compound the offences with the present petitioner also.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner has already been declared proclaimed offender, but the offences are under Sections 323, 324 and 34 IPC which are bailable.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the fact that parties have already effected compromise, I find that no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody. Therefore, finding merit in the present petition, the same is allowed. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within 10 days from today and on doing so, he shall be released on bail by the trial Court to its satisfaction. If the petitioner fails to appear before the trial Court within the stipulated period, instant petition shall be treated as dismissed.
