Petitioner-Vikramjit Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.05 dated 20.01.2018, registered at Police Station Sekhwan, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 427, 379, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that neither the present petitioner has been named in the FIR, nor any role has been attributed to him. However, injured-Harjeet Singh has named the

present petitioner later on in his statement under Section 161 Cr.P.C. and stated that the present petitioner was armed with spade and gave its blow on his nose. The said injury falls under Section 325 IPC.

Challan has already been presented. The petitioner has been in custody since 06.02.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
