Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of order dated 6.4.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State on instructions from ASI Surjit Singh has affirmed the factum of joining the investigation by the petitioner.

However, learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and submits that the petitioner and other persons have formed a group and the petitioner is also involved in one more case under Section 307 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is

on bail in that case and no other case is pending against him.

In view of the above, interim order dated 6.4.2018 passed in favour of the petitioner is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.

However, it is made clear that in case any misuse of the weapon is there as per terms and conditions of the license, the concerned authority may take necessary action.
