The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.223 dated 01.09.2017, under Sections 34, 376, 452, 506 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Barauda, Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner herein was into custody in the aforesaid FIR on 01.09.2017. It is submitted that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case. It is also contended that investigation is complete, as the challan has been presented, therefore, the petitioner is entitled to be enlarged on bail.

Per contra, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State, on instructions from Investigating Officer, opposes the grant of

regular bail to the petitioner, while submitting that offences alleged against the petitioner are serious in nature.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since, the trial is likely to take some time and in view of the facts that the petitioner herein has been in custody since 01.09.2017 and that investigation is complete, as the challan has been presented, no useful purpose would be served in keeping the petitioner behind bars. At this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
