Present petition filed under Section 407 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short ' the Code') read with Section 482 of the Code for transfer of the case titled as *State Vs. Ishwar* (Sessions Case No.30/5.10.2015) arising out of FIR No.263 dated 08.04.2015, under Sections 323, 324, 307, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Jhajjar.

It is undisputably submitted that complainant-Jugan Singh and his son Abhimanyu Chauhan are practising as an advocate at District Jhajjar and trial is pending in the court of Additional Sessions Judge, Jhajjar. It has been submitted that there is apprehension that the respondent will influence the witnesses.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the petition is allowed and case is transferred to the court of learned Sessions Judge, Rohtak, who either himself decide the case or entrusted to any other court of competent jurisdiction. Further, court is directed to expedite the matter and record the evidence within a period of six months from the date of receipt of the record of the trial court.
