Petitioners have filed the present petition for issuance of directions to the official respondents to look into the grievance of the petitioners.

Respondents No.4 and 5 are brothers-in-law of petitioner No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that after the demise of Jaswinder Singh, the petitioners are living in the joint house. There was an instance of beatings and dragging of the petitioners on 05.11.2017 for which the matter was reported to the police, but no action was taken. Again beatings were given on 02.01.2018 and offensive remarks were made against petitioners No.1 and 2.

Precisely for the grievance in question, the petitioners

have already filed representation before respondent No.2 on 04.01.2018 but no action has been taken so far.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Hittan Nehra, Additional A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

At this stage, in view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of filing any reply to the petition as no order prejudicial to interest of any of the party is being passed.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioners in context of their representation dated 04.01.2018 and to act in accordance with the parameters as laid down in **Lalita Kumari v. Govt. of U.P. (2014) 2 SCC (1).**
