**ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.**

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.43 dated 10.05.2017, registered under Sections 363, 366-A of IPC (lateron added Sections 342, 376 and 109 of IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act, 2012) at Police Station Kot Fatta, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 08.07.2017 and the girl had gone on her own and in her statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. she does not make any allegations against the petitioner and there are no allegations of rape against the petitioner and the allegations of allurement are against Sukhpreet.

No allegations of rape have been levelled against the petitioner. He is in custody since July, 2017.

The trial would taken time. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds

to the satisfaction of trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate with a condition that he would not tamper with evidence.
