The present petition has been filed praying for quashing of FIR No.126 dated 15.10.2007, under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 325 and 326 of IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar.

In terms of order dated 31.10.2018, learned State counsel has filed affidavit of Navjot Singh Mahal PPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Jalandhar (Rural) in the Court today. The same is taken on record.

On instructions from ASI Suriender Singh, learned State counsel submits that the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already

been submitted in the above mentioned FIR before the Court of competent jurisdiction.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to raise all the pleas available under law at the appropriate stage(s).

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
