Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Sr. Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A copy of the paper-book be handed over to her during the course of the day.

In this application filed under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks his release on bail after a non-bailable warrant of arrest was issued against him on 9th November, 2017. He was already on bail in the pending trial in which even his statement under Section 313 Cr.P.C. had also been recorded.

The petitioner however absented without intimation on the aforesaid date, on account of which the warrant was ordered to be issued against him.

Petitioner's contention is that he could not attend Court on that day on account of in deposition and to support this, he had also placed on record a copy of his Medical Certificate (Annexure P-1).

In the given circumstances, the petition is allowed to the extent that operation of the warrant issued against the petitioner is stayed for one week from today.

The petitioner in the meantime surrender before the Ld. Trial Court and seek fresh bail within this period.

This order shall automatically stand vacated after one week from today.
