The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.134 dated 13.08.2015, under Sections 363, 366-A, 376(D), 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

By an order of even date passed in CRM-M-14156 of 2018, the petitioner herein has been directed to surrender/appear before the trial court, to face the trial.

Contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that some of the co-accused have been acquitted, is a ground that is available to him to take up before the trial court. This court is not inclined to interfere in the matter.

In view of the above, with the direction to the trial court to

conclude the matter expeditiously, the petition in hand stands disposed of.
