This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by a young girl aged 21 years with the allegations that her parents and family members forcibly want to marry her whereas she is interested in studying further.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Nishchal Mann, DAG, Haryana Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Counsel submits that petitioner is a student of second year in nursing course and that she is presently residing in the house of her cousin sister and brother-in-law because her parents are interfering in her peaceful life and forcing her to get married. She apprehends that the private respondents would cause her physical harm and adopting unlawful means to remove her from the house of her cousin sister and brother-in-law. A representation (Annexure P-2) has already been submitted in this regard.

In the facts and circumstances of this case, I deem it appropriate to

dispose of this petition with directions to respondent No. 2 to inquire into the allegations made in the representation (Annexure P-2) and in case they are found to be true to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.
