This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.261 dated 23.7.2017 under sections 15, 25, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, Madhuban, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery of 74 kgs poppy husk was effected from a truck being driven by co-accused Gurmeet Singh.

Present petitioner is stated to be the owner of the truck in question from where the alleged recovery was effected.

Petitioner was arrested on 23.7.2017.

Investigation in the case is complete and even challan has been presented.

Petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other case under the N.D.P.S Act.

Co-accused Gurmeet Singh has been granted benefit of bail in the light of order dated 16.3.2018 passed in CRM-M-3495-2018.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Petition disposed of.
