Two separate affidavits of petitioners No.1 and 2 have been filed in Court, which are taken on record.

Petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from respondent Nos. 4 to 6 and have, therefore, highlighted this position in their representation dated 03.04.2018 (Annexure P-5) addressed to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana-respondent No.2.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana-respondent No.2 and S.H.O., P.S. Haibowal, District Ludhiana-respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 03.04.2018 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana-respondent No.2 and S.H.O., P.S. Haibowal, District Ludhiana-respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 03.04.2018 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
