RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.136 dated 13.09.2016 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 341/323/506/148/149/201 IPC and Section 3 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984, at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 27.03.2018 (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to order dated 06.04.2018 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 30.04.2018 to get their statements recorded. Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sangrur, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.358, dated 11.05.2018 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Sangrur, vide Endst. No.3236/EB, dated 14.05.2018.

According to the report, learned Additional Chief Judicial

Magistrate, Sangrur, is satisfied that compromise entered into between the

parties is genuine, voluntary, without any coercion or undue influence with their free will.

Considering the report of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sangrur, dated 11.05.2018 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, aforesaid FIR No.136 dated 13.09.2016 (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, is quashed, subject to payment of costs of ₹10,000/-, out of which ₹6,000/- shall be deposited with the Punjab State Legal Services Authority and ₹4,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana High Court within two weeks from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.

Disposed of accordingly.
