RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

1. Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing FIR No. 432 dated 15.06.2016 under Sections 420/406 of the IPC at Police Station Ballabgarh City District Faridabad (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) effected between the parties.

2. Vide orders dated 01.08.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court, to furnish a report qua veracity of the compromise.

3. Consequently, parties appeared before the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridabad and got recorded their statements qua compromise on 10.08.2018. Report from the Additional Chief Judicial

Magistrate, Faridabad, vide letter No. 899 dated 20.08.2018, duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Faridabad, vide letter No. 20563/H.4 (Status), Dated 23.08.2018, has been received. According to the report of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridabad, the compromise is genuine and it is voluntarily effected between the parties with their free consent and without any pressure, threat, coercion or undue influence from any side.

4. In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, this petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR No. 432 dated 15.06.2016 under Sections 420/406 of the IPC at Police Station Ballabgarh City District Faridabad (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioner is quashed, subject to payment of costs of Rs. 10,000/-, out of which Rs. 4,000/- shall be deposited with the Bar Association of Punjab and Haryana, High Court, Rs. 1000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and Rs. 5,000/- with High Court Legal Services Committee, within two weeks from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
