The petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty and also for directing respondent No. 4 not to interfere in his personal life and liberty.

As per the allegations in the petition, respondent No. 4 is wife of the petitioner and has eloped with her lover and has stolen jewellery as well as cash belonging to the petitioner.

Under the circumstances, no directions can be issued to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as no threat is forthcoming from respondent No. 4 or her alleged paramour. Moreover, a legally wedded wife can not be restrained from interfering in the life and liberty of her husband.

The petition is without any merit and is dismissed.
