Prayer in the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of regular bail to petitioners in a case arising from FIR No.104 dated 09.03.2015 under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Indri, District Karnal, Haryana.

According to the prosecution, petitioner No.1 as a director of M/s Prachi Gas Bottling Pvt. Ltd. was supposed to return a cheque amounting to Rs.20.00 lakh to the complainant, which was deposited by the complainant as a security to get a dealership of the gas agency.

Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* contends that around 110 FIRs have been registered against the petitioners with similar allegations on the complaints of different complainants in five States. The matter is of civil nature. Since the petitioners are in custody from 2016, therefore, in almost 10 cases of similar nature, they have been granted bail by this Court as well as its Coordinate Benches vide orders Annexures P-3 and P-4 colly.

expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed.

Consequently, petitioners are ordered to be released on bail, on their furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
