RAJ SHEKHAR ATTRI, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner was facing trial for the offence punishable under Sections 379-B, 34 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') in case FIR No.0150 dated 15.07.2017 registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshairpur.

Earlier petitioner was on bail but on 04.01.2018, he did not appear, therefore, the bail bonds were cancelled and he was ordered to be summoned through non-bailable warrants of arrest.

It has been submitted that petitioner was bed ridden and for this reason, he failed to attend the proceedings. He relied upon medical certificate (AnnexureP-2) which transpires that he was having severe back pain on 10.12.2017 and he was advised complete bed rest for two months. It seems to be genuine ground.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 06.04.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
