Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.63 dated 21.02.2018 under sections 307, 148, 149 I.P.C and sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station, Division No.7, Ludhiana.

Counsel for the parties have been heard at length.

Perusal of the FIR would reveal that there was a quarrel between two groups. Present petitioner is specifically named in the FIR and is alleged to be amongst a group of 20/25 persons who came on motorcycles and cars armed with pistols, *kirpans*, *daangs*, *soti* etc. A quarrel between two groups is stated to have taken place. The entire group has then gone on a rampage and even resorted to firing in which one passerby namely Inderjeet Singh son of Jaswinder Singh has suffered a fire arm injury in his left leg.

It is a case where the recovery of fire arm is yet to be effected and it is to be ascertained as to which group was the aggressor party. Name of the petitioner figures in the FIR.

Against the backdrop of the allegations, custodial interrogation of the petitioner may well be warranted.

Prayer of the petitioner seeking concession of pre-arrest bail is declined.

Petition is dismissed.
