The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0041 dated 10.03.2018, registered under Section 379 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Phase-I, SAS Nagar Mohali.

FIR has been lodged against the petitioner by her father-in-law on the allegation that she has stolen the car.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Raj Kumar submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from her. Apart from it, compromise has been effected between the parties.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 03.05.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
