Prayer in this petition is for quashing the FIR No. 37 dated 26.02.2015, registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of the IPC (Annexure P-1) at Police Station Zirakpur, District S.A.S. Nagar along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

This petition is pending since 2015 and there is no stay of proceedings before the trial Court. In the meantime, police has submitted the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. and charges have been framed by the trial Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ajit Singh, submits that now the trial Court is recording the statement of prosecution witnesses and statement of two prosecution witnesses have already been recorded.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this petition be rendered infructuous and liberty be granted to the petitioner to raise all the pleas during the course of trial.

Dismissed as infructuous with the liberty as prayed for.
