Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of F.I.R. No.17 dated 10.03.2017 registered under Sections 295, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Fattu Dyinga, District Kapurthala (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 18.03.2017 (Annexure P-2).

This Court vide order dated 24.04.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

However, a communication dated 10.05.2017 has been received from learned Sub Divisional Magistrate, Sultanpur Lodhi to the effect that the complainant-Gursharan Singh has not turned up in Court for making statement in support of the compromise.

No one is present on behalf of the petitioners. Even on the last date of hearing i.e. 06.04.2018, no one was present on their behalf. It shows either there is no compromise between the parties or the petitioners are not interested to pursue the present petition.

Dismissed for want of prosecution.

However, it shall not debar the petitioners from filing a fresh petition either on merits or on compromise if so arrived at between them.
