The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, "Cr.P.C.) for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 69 dated 19.02.2018, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 379-B, 411, 34 IPC, at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

Heard.

It is stated that VIVO while colour mobile phone was snatched by two unknown persons. However, said mobile phone has already been recovered from co-accused – Johny. It is further submitted that motor-cycle bearing registration No. PB-39-D-4147 belongs to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is in custody since 23.02.2018.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Harjinder Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to the conditions, if any, and on

furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
