The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, "Cr.P.C.) for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0019 dated 24.02.2018, registered for the offences punishable under Section 379-B, 411, 34 IPC, at Police Station B Division, Amritsar.

Heard.

It is stated that the snatched mobile phone has been recovered from co-accused of the petitioner, who has already been granted the concession of bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is in custody since 25.02.2018.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner - Nishan Singh @ Chula is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to the conditions, if any, and on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate subject to following

terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
