Petitioner seeks concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.67 dated 4.11.2017 under sections 307, 323, 324, 506, 382, 148, 149 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Mattewal, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the complaint of Paramjit Singh in relation to an occurrence dated 1.11.2017 in the late evening hours.

As per complainant, he was physically assaulted and inflicted injuries by a number of persons including the present petitioner.

The specific attribution to the present petitioner is of having inflicted *kirpan* blows on his left hand/wrist.

The document placed on record at Annexure P-2 i.e. M.L.R dated 27.11.2017 contains the description of the injuries suffered by the complainant and at the hands of the present petitioner and reads as follows:-

“INJURIES;

1. *Linear scar 6.5 cm along with multiple suture scars intercepting the main scar is present over the front of left forearm in its lower end starting 7.4 cm above middle of crease of wrist going obliquely downward and outward extending*

upto the outer aspect of crease of wrist joint.

2. *Linear scar 12.2 cm with multiple suture scars intercepting the main scars is obliquely present over the palmer aspect of left hand starting at the level of outer part of crease of wrist joint going obliquely downward and inward extending upto the base of little finger of left hand. Diffuse swelling of the hand and fingers is present. Fingers of the hand are flexed, swollen and injured is unable to move any of the finger. Sensation to touch is also absent from the fingers.*
3. *Linear scar 4.4 cm with multiple suture scars intercepting the main scar is obliquely present on the palmer aspect of left hand starting from the middle part of injury no.2 going obliquely downward and outward.”*

Offence under section 307 I.P.C has been cited on account of the injuries attributed to the present petitioner.

Complainant's version finds corroboration from the medical record.

In the light of the serious allegations and the gravity of the offence, petitioner is not held entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail.

Petition is dismissed.
