The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against them vide FIR No.196 dated 25.08.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 188, 436, 427 and 120-B Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Cheeka.

The allegations, in nutshell, are that the petitioners alongwith others had set on fire a diesel machine installed at petrol pump, where the complainant was working.

Notice of motion was issued to the respondent.

It has been informed by learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Rajbir Singh, that the petitioners have joined the investigation and that challan had already been presented qua co-accused Major Singh and Milkhi Ram. The name of the present petitioners had surfaced subsequently in the disclosure statements made by the co-accused and that challan is likely to be filed shortly against the present petitioners as well.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and also learned counsel for the State as well as bearing in mind the aforesaid facts, especially that the investigation in the present case qua the present petitioners is also stated to be complete, the present petition is accepted and the interim directions made by this Court vide order dated 10.04.2018 are made absolute, subject to the condition that the petitioners shall appear before the Investigating Officer as and when directed and would fully cooperate with the investigation.
