There is no representation from the petitioner's side despite the case having been taken up twice. Today, petitioners No.1, 12, 13, 14 and 16 have been duly served, whereas notice issued to petitioners No.2, 7 received back with the report that they are not residing at the given address and there is no other address available with the Court. Petitioner No.17 has refused to accept the notice.

The present writ petition has been filed by different petitioners seeking redressal of their grievance but despite issuance of notices to the petitioners none has put in appearance on their behalf. It appears that the petitioners are not interested to pursue the matter.

In view of the above, present writ petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
