Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

Heard.

Respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala, is directed to look into the representation dated 04.04.2018 (Annexure P-5), moved by the petitioners as per law. He is also directed to inquire about the age of petitioner No.1-Amandeep Kaur and if she is found to be less than 18 years, then he is at liberty to take necessary action as per law. Further, if respondent No.2 is satisfied that the petitioners are actually facing serious threat, then he shall take necessary steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from private respondents, as per law.

With aforesaid directions, this petition stands disposed of.

However, it is made clear that this order, in no way, will affect any other proceedings pending or to be filed against the petitioners etc., which are to be dealt with independently as per law.
