Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0276 dated 22.10.2017 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 285, 307, 341, 427, 506 IPC and Sections 25/27 Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station City Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Learned State counsel has submitted that no doubt, the petition *qua* Vikramjeet @ Vicky, petitioner no.2 has already been withdrawn, whereas petitioner no.1–Darshan Singh has straightaway approached this Court for grant of anticipatory bail, without availing the remedy before the Sessions Court.

Faced with the aforesaid situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the Court of Sessions for the relief claimed in the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
