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**SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)**

In this petition, the petitioner seeks his release on anticipatory bail in F.I.R. No.348, dated 26.09.2017, under Sections 419, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Focal Point, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that his client is unable to access to the original of Annexure P-3, since the same was retained by the person who showed to him, and he is also unable to procure attendance of such person before this Court.

3. It is, however, further submitted that whatsoever was done by

the petitioner was on instructions of Lambardar Gurbachan Singh, who is the accused and has since been arrested by the Police.

4. After hearing both sides, this Court is of the opinion that in a case where not only a Will was forged but even identity papers of the supposed signatories on the said Will had been created, there appears to be a deep rooted conspiracy (already noted in the last order), to unfold which, close custodial interrogation of the petitioner would certainly be required.

5. Dismissed.
