Present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.39 dated 28.02.2018 under Sections 406, 420, 506, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned State counsel contended that, despite several adjournments, the petitioner has not cooperated with the investigating agency and, as such, effective investigation could not be carried out.

In view of the above, the present petition for pre-arrest bail is not maintainable and is dismissed.
