The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.129 dated 26.07.2017, registered under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur.

The recovery effected from the petitioner falls within non-commercial quantity.

The instant petition has been filed for grant of bail solely on the ground that the petitioner is in custody since 26.07.2017.

To the mind of this Court, the petitioner does not deserve the concession of regular bail in commercial quantity.

Therefore, the instant petition stands dismissed. However, the learned trial court is directed to expedite the trial and dispose of the same within a period of six months.
