GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

The petitioners seek quashing of complaint No.30 dated 2.8.2014 registered under Sections 452, 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 as well as summoning order dated 18.11.2015 and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 16.4.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Malerkotla (Sangrur) has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of complainants Darshan Singh and Avtar Singh and also of the accused have been recorded to the effect that they have entered into a compromise and they have no objection in case the complaint in question is quashed. It has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise

voluntarily and without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and complaint No.30 dated 2.8.2014 registered under Sections 452, 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 as well as summoning order dated 18.11.2015 and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
