Through this application, prayer has been made for preponing the matter and placing on record compromise (Annexure P-4) along with copies of Annexures P-5 to P-7.

Application is allowed. Documents are taken on record.

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of regular bail to petitioner Arun Kumar in a case arising from FIR No.166 dated 17.09.2017 under Sections 452/323/324/326/307/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.3, Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that co-accused of the petitioner namely Dheeraj Kumar @ Ishu and Sagar Kataria have been granted bail by this Court. More so, compromise has been

effected between the petitioner and the complainant. The petitioner is also entitled for bail treating his case on the same parity as that of his co-accused. The conclusion of trial shall take a long time.

Considering over-all facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Consequently, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
