The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 0134 dated 26.08.2017, registered under Sections 148, 149, 188, 427, 436, 124-A, 120-B, 394 IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 at Police Station Guhla, District Kaithal.

The petitioner is alleged to have indulged in violence and rioting after the conviction of Baba Gurmeet Ram Rahim.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been named in this case on the basis of statements of co-accused, ten days after the registration of the FIR. No overt act is attributed to him and he has been in custody since 06.09.2017 and now the investigation is complete as the challan has been presented.

The factual averments of learned counsel for the petitioner are not denied by learned State counsel.

Keeping in view the totality of the facts and circumstances of this case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner – Jasbir @ Laddi s/o Balbir Singh, is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
