The land of the petitioner, situated in Village Lehra Mohabbat, District Bathinda, was acquired for construction of a Thermal Power Plant at Bathinda. As per his qualifications, he was offered appointment as Regular T-Mate (RTM), a Class-IV post, on priority basis in terms of the Policy dated 18.07.1994 for giving employment on priority basis to one member of the affected family, whose land had been acquired.

The claim of the petitioner for appointment as Clerk was rejected as he did not fulfill the prescribed qualifications of Graduation at the time of offer of appointment. Hence, the present writ petition.

At the time of hearing, the petitioner, who is present in person, concedes that the present writ petition has become infructuous as during his employment as RTM and on passing of the departmental examination, he stood promoted to the post of Clerk in the year 2002. As such, the petitioner is fully satisfied and does not want to pursue the present petition.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Since the main petition stands disposed of as infructuous, the pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
