Petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from respondent Nos. 4 to 7 and have, therefore, highlighted this position in their representation dated 05.04.2018 (Annexure P-5/T) addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur-respondent No.2.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur-respondent No.2 and S.H.O., Police Station Guru Har Sahai, District Ferozepur-respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 05.04.2018 (Annexure P-5/T) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur-respondent No.2 and S.H.O., Police Station Guru Har Sahai, District Ferozepur-respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 05.04.2018 (Annexure P-5/T) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
