The petitioner has filed this petition seeking protection of his life and liberty. He apprehends that private respondents may harm him physically.

Notice of motion. Mr. A.S. Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.4 to 6, at this stage.

The petitioner has made representation dated 15.02.2018 (Annexure P-1) to respondent Nos.2 and 3 alleging that the private respondents have made him sign blank papers for which a complaint was made by the petitioner to the police. To pressurize the petitioner to withdraw his complaint, physical threats are being held out.

The petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.3 to consider the complaint (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioner. In case it appears that his life and liberty is being threatened, appropriate action in accordance with law be taken within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
