Harinder Singh Sidhu, J. :

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure read with Article 21 of the Constitution of India seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 7 to provide police protection to the petitioner to enable her to harvest her wheat crop.

The petitioner is a widow. It is alleged that the respondents No.8 to 15 are not permitting her to harvest her crop. She claims to be the owner in possession of the land, wherein, she has sown wheat crop, which is ripe for harvesting. It is claimed that 50% of the land has been purchased by her and the remaining 50% has been Willed in her favour by her late mother.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier police enquiry was also initiated, wherein, possession and ownership of the petitioner were established. The petitioner has made two representations dated 19.1.2018 and 26.3.2018 (Annexures P-6 and P-7), addressed to the

Senior Superintendent of Police, Jagraon, but no action thereon has been taken.

Having considered the submissions made, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 – SSP, Jagraon to look into the grievance of the petitioner raised in the aforesaid representations (Annexures P-6 and P-7) and take action thereon, in accordance with law.
