The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.442 dated 10th August, 2017, registered under Sections 148, 149, 307, 452, 506 of the Indian Penal Code (for short, 'the IPC') (Section 384, 201, 120-B of the IPC added later on) and Section 25/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

2. Seen the Case Diary.
3. Investigation already completed and challan submitted.

4. The petitioner was arrested on 28th August, 2017.
5. Admittedly, the petitioner was not named in the FIR.
6. The available material indicating his presence at the spot basically emanates only from the disclosure statement of the co-accused persons. Thereafter, a motorcycle allegedly used in the occurrence is stated to have been recovered at his instance.
7. As such role of the present petitioner appears somewhat similarly to that of co-accused Ravinder Singh who has already been granted bail by this Court.
8. Considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, he may be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned with a further direction that he shall report himself at the concerned Police Station once a week initially for a period of four months after which continuation of this condition shall be left to the discretion of the Ld. Trial Court.
