The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, "Cr.P.C.") for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 84 dated 25.10.2017, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302/201/120-B IPC, at Police Station Sadar Banga, District SBS Nagar (Nawanshahr).

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no evidence against the petitioner.

However, learned State counsel relies upon statement of one Shashi Kumar wherein it has been mentioned Rohit has suffered a confession for committing murder of Deepika in connivance with Rajni. There is no extra-judicial statement by the petitioner. Even there is no direct or circumstantial evidence connecting the petitioner with the crime.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner - Rajni is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to the conditions, if any, and on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of her absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel her bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure her presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) She shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
