GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No. 783 dated 9.12.2017 under Sections 420 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), Police Station DLF-II, Gurugram District Gurugram and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 20.04.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurugram has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioner as well as of complainant-Bhushan Kapur have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that the complainant has no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurugram that the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 783 dated 9.12.2017 under Sections 420 IPC, Police Station DLF-II, Gurugram District Gurugram and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
