Petitioner has filed this criminal revision petition for transfer of investigation of case bearing FIR No.5 dated 08.01.2014 registered under Sections 460, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Nakodar to Central Bureau of Investigation or Crime Branch.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that FIR was registered on 08.01.2014, but the police did not take any action for more than three years. It was only when this petition was filed and order dated 20.08.2015 was passed, the police swung into action and has filed the status report showing that

the main accused namely Kumar Dung Dung has since been declared to be a proclaimed offender on 26.03.2015 and the police will act in accordance with law. FIR No.255 dated 03.09.2015 under Section 174-A IPC has already been registered against the main accused.

In the light of this development, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition, however liberty is granted to the petitioner to file fresh petition, in case, some new cause of action accrues in his favour.

Dismissed as not pressed with liberty aforesaid.
