The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.399 dated 30.05.2017, registered under Sections 186, 332, 335, 333, 307, 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Civil Lines, Karnal.

The petitioner is not named in the FIR. However, no injury has been attributed to him. He has been dragged in the aforesaid FIR solely on the ground that co-accused David alias Khillu suffered disclosure statement that the fire arm was arranged by the petitioner much prior to the occurrence.

The petitioner is in custody since 31.07.2017. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody any further.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Ankit alias Billi is ordered

to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Karnal, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
